- > No refunds or walk-ons will be issued when a skater misses a session due to injury or illness or when Acts of God result in a cancellation (i.e. loss of power at the rink).
- > All balances must be paid in full before skaters will be allowed to participate in the Ice Show or in the club the following year.
- > COVID-related cancellations by the rink itself will be credited to a skater's account prior to the Ice Show.
- ➤ Package discounts are PER SKATER and apply to FREESTYLE packages purchased by Sept 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- > The highest price package is full price, additional packages are discounted at 85% of the package cost.
- > 50% of package costs are due in September. The remaining 50% must be received no later than January 31, 2022. Make checks out to CIFSC.
- > A \$50 late fee will be applied to all late payments.

## How to Skate a Package

#### **GENERAL INFO:**

- There is a lot of different activity on a freestyle session and it requires your special awareness.
- Skate as if you are crossing a busy street. Look both ways before leaving the boards. Always skate defensively; be on the lookout for other skaters.
- When not skating, skaters should stay close to the boards or in the player boxes.
- Do not stand on the ends of the rink: many Moves patterns come very close to the end boards of the rink.

#### FLOW OF THE ICE:

- Spins should be done in the center of the ice.
- The ends of the arena are for jumping, or are considered the jump zone, especially the corners. Don't stand around those areas.
- Keep moving: standing means someone has to maneuver around you, which can cause an accident.

#### SKATER RIGHT OF WAY:

- A skater in a lesson has the right of way. Be aware, pay attention and yield the right of way to all skaters that are in lessons.
- A skater whose program/dance music is being played also has the right of way. Listen to the announcer announce whose program is being played and yield the right of way to this skater. They will also have a sash on while they are skating their program.

#### **SMART SKATER RULES:**

- Keep your head up and be aware of other skaters around you. Any personal listening devices such as cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, or anything with headphones are forbidden during package time. Skaters not only need to watch for other skaters but also listen for them.
- Do not stand around in groups and talk. (A coach/rink monitor may tell you to disperse)
- If you fall, get up right away. If you are hurt, stay still on the ice until a coach reaches you.
- Do not stay in one place on the ice. Do not skate on the hockey circle the entire session.
- Be on time for your sessions, especially after a resurface. Use every minute of your ice time to the maximum. (Instructors appreciate students being on time)
- Be aware when someone is having a harness lesson. They have the right of way.
- Stretch before getting on the ice and always be careful stretching on or off the ice so you don't accidentally kick someone.
- NO FOOD OR GUM ON THE ICE. Be careful with drinks or the rink may ban them from the ice. Water is the only drink permitted on the ice.
- Please do not litter or leave anything on the ice. Items left on the ice may severely damage the Zamboni, and it is inconsiderate to others to leave your used tissues along the boards. Used Kleenexes should be placed into your pocket or a small baggie for disposal.
- Skaters are required to fill holes, chips, and gouges in the ice at the END OF EACH SESSION. Please use the bucket at the Zamboni end to FILL THE HOLES.
- Be kind to one another both on and off the ice
  - o Say, "excuse me", if you can see that another skater does not see you coming.
  - o Say, "I'm sorry" when you accidentally get in someone else's way, especially if they had the right of way. (It does happen sometimes).
- Skate with common sense!

Everyone has the same right to skate every session. Everyone has paid the same fee. But also, everyone shares the same responsibility to skate safely and be aware of others on the ice.

#### RINK MONITORS - ICE RINK PACKAGE MANAGEMENT

As the Rink Monitor, you are the "adult in charge" during the ice time package. You are responsible for:

- Arriving a few minutes early, reporting to the "music playing box", signing in the log book and getting prepared to organize skater CDs before the package begins
- Taking attendance for the skaters in the package
- Playing CDs for the skaters
- Telling the skaters to move off the ice, into the boxes, if they need to talk
- Reminding skaters to stay out of the way of skaters receiving lessons or the skater whose music is being played
- Providing any first aid that may need to be administered. There is a first aid kit located in the locked CIFSC box, as well as baggies which can be filled to be used as ice packs. There is also a list of emergency contact numbers for all CIFSC skaters located in the box in the back of the 3-ring binder.
- Please contact a board member if there are any problems that you feel need to be addressed.

Be sure to check the Rink Monitor Schedule — the schedule can be found on the CIFSC website and in the package binder at the rink. You will be charged \$20 for each no-show. BOTH PARENTS listed on the schedule MUST show up for rink monitor duties; if one parent is needed for an emergency, the other can keep CDs playing.

If the date you are scheduled for doesn't work out for you, you may switch with another parent. <u>Please notify the Rink Monitor Coordinator if you switch dates with someone</u>. Also, be sure to sign-in if you filled in for someone who was a no-show so you can receive credit for doing so.

#### **CD PLAYING PROCEDURES**

- During the first couple of minutes of the package, skaters will give you their CDs and then warm-up on the ice. Organize the CDs in the order in which they were received to skate. Please be sure to never SLIDE the CDs across the table as they scratch easily.
- After 5 minutes of warm-up, using the microphone, announce the first skater's CD to be played and also the skater who is next in order. Example: "Heather Smith is up; Maggie Jones is on deck."
- Skaters must wear a sash when their music is being played. When the skater is in the ready position, start the CD and get the "on deck" skater's music ready. The skater "on deck" should put on a sash as soon their name called, so as to be ready when the previous skater's music ends. Please your best to change discs quickly as it will allow more opportunities for each skater to skate their program.
- Once a skater begins the program (except during a lesson), the CD cannot be stopped and restarted, unless there are technical difficulties.
- Three minutes prior to the end of the package please announce that pick holes must be filled. Announcement: <u>ALL</u> skaters please fill pick holes.
- Return the CDs to their cases and return to the skaters at the end of the package.
- <u>If you are the last package of the evening</u>, please return the binder, CD case, CD player and sashes to the CIFSC box and lock the box.
- If there are no skaters needing music to be played, personal music may be played as long as the music does NOT include any inappropriate language.

#### CIFSC VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS

In order to ensure the success of our volunteer-led organization, it is very important that all members support the club through their time and energy. As a result, there is not a buyout option for Volunteer Hours, and hours that are not fulfilled will be fined at a rate of \$50/hour. Skaters will also not be allowed to skate the next available session (spring/summer/fall) if a family's volunteer requirement has not been met or the fine has not been paid.

Volunteer opportunity information and sign-up sheets will be available online through cifsc.net and will occasionally be sent to the club via email. Please note that Rink Monitor hours, the Red Panther HS Team hour, and credit-earning hours (such as working concessions, Riverfront shifts, selling Butter Braids) DO NOT count towards the volunteer hour requirement.

By joining the Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club all members agree to complete at least 4 volunteer hours per skater, with a maximum of 6 hours per family. 1 hour per skater or 2 per family MUST be completed during the ice show, and all hours need to be completed by the end of this season's Ice Show. If a skater does not sign up for the Ice Show, the Ice Show hours must be completed through another volunteer opportunity. Board discretion will be used if unforeseen circumstances prevent a family from fulfilling their hours.

In order to submit volunteer hours that were not tracked through a club sign-up page, please email the Volunteer Coordinator Directly. This would include any activity for the club such as costumes, website management, props committee...

### **SCRIP REBATE PROGRAM**

CIFSC sponsors a scrip program which allows you to purchase scrip (gift cards). The scrip you purchase through our program generates rebates from the participating retailers. Then you can use these rebates you've earned as a credit towards your skaters ice fees. This rebate program will run all year long, allowing you to earn credits throughout the year. These earned credits can be used towards your fall, spring or summer ice packages.

Example of how it works:

By doing a little planning ahead and purchasing the cards you will need to do your monthly shopping, you could easily be adding \$60 a month towards your skaters ice fees!

Orders are due on the last day of every month by 8:00 p.m. Payment is due at the time of the order through presto pay only. Any orders received after the due date, will not be placed until the following month.

Once gift cards are delivered and sorted everyone who has ordered scrip will receive an email to set up pick-up times.

#### **K.B.** Willett Concessions Information

Adult CIFSC family members have the opportunity to work in the concession stand at the K. B. Willett Arena during Saturday and Tuesday Learn to Skate (LTS) and Saturday and Sunday Public Skate Sessions. Workers must be 18 years or older (no one under the age of 18 is allowed in the concessions area). Workers are <u>required</u> to attend a 30-minute training session prior to working in the concession stand for the first time. The date and time for the mandatory training for all concession workers will be announced as soon as it is set.

The skater's ice package costs will be credited approximately \$6/hour for each hour worked. In addition, at the end of the skating season, a **concession bonus check** is received by the club and those funds will be divided up according to the number of hours worked and this additional credit can be used towards the following year's fall ice packages. **No cash payments** will be made for hours worked beyond the skater's package costs.

If you sign up for concessions and fail to show up, the K.B. Willett penalty charge for no-shows will be passed on to you. <u>This penalty is substantial</u>! Please make sure to mark your selected dates on your calendar. If you have a conflict it is **your responsibility** to find a replacement, please notify concession crew board member April Brown of any changes.

Sign up for concessions will be online only and will begin on . At this time you may sign up for 3 shifts per skater. We will be using SignUp.com com (the leading online SignUp and reminder tool) for concession stand sign up.

#### To sign up for a shift:

Here's how it works in 3 easy steps:

- 1) Link will be sent via email.
- 2) Review the options listed and choose the spot(s) you like.
- 3) Sign up! It's Easy you will NOT need to register an account or keep a password on SignUp.com.

Note: SignUp.com does not share your email address with anyone.

If you prefer not to use your email address, please contact me and I can sign you up manually.

If you see a date that is still open three days prior, you may take that shift even if you have already worked, or are signed up to work, the maximum three shifts

an open Saturday shift can be filled on the previous Wednesday

an open Sunday shift can be filled on the previous Thursday

an open Tuesday shift can be filled on the previous Saturday

Please add "unfilled shift" in the comments dialogue box if you are signing up for one of these shifts. If you sign up for an open shift too early, your entry will be deleted.
