Dear Parents and Show Skaters:

The 2022-2023 ice show skaters will skate to the "Ice School Musical" theme. We will have three shows. Two shows on Saturday, April 1st, at 2:00pm and 7:00pm. The third show will be on Sunday, April 2nd, at 2:00pm. **All participants must skate all three shows.** We need the cooperation of all skaters and parents to prepare for this wonderful community event.

## **ICE SHOW T-SHIRT DESIGN VOTING ends Tuesday, February 21<sup>st</sup>**

Skaters vote on the t-shirt design they would like for the 2023 Ice School Musical show. Each skater may vote once. ## **OPENING NUMBER Registration ends Tuesday, February 21st**

The opening number is available to all Freestyle skaters who are registered for a Freestyle Number in the show (Glee Club, Cruisin' for a Bruisin', Detention, and Footloose). The costume for this year is black pants (no leggings, jeggings or jeans) and the 2023 ice show t-shirt. We will have 2 rehearsals. You must be on the ice for both practices for the entire time to skate in the number. Please don't sign up if you know you can't make it to one of them. Please arrive on time. The shirt cost is \$12.00 and needs to be ordered online. If a shirt is not ordered for you, you cannot be in the number. [Register Here](#)

## **PICTURE DAY & Costume distribution – Saturday, March 4<sup>th</sup>**

Skaters will receive their costumes as they enter the rink. Please see the picture day schedule in this packet for your skater's picture time.

All skaters need suntan-colored tights unless they are wearing pants as a costume. Tights are not included with your costume but will be available for purchase for \$12.00 for child sizes and \$14.00 for adult sizes.

Female skaters wearing non-white skates must wear white boot covers. Males wearing non-black skates must wear black boot covers. Boot covers are not included with your costume but will be available for purchase for \$10.00-15.00.

Our photographer, Empire Photography, will email a link with a passcode directly to each parent to view/purchase photos. See the Picture Schedule for more information regarding photos.

Skaters' pictures will be published in the Ice Show Program. Each skater gets one program free of charge. Additional programs will be for purchase each show or until supplies last.

## SHOW TICKETS GO ON SALE – Wednesday, March 1<sup>st</sup> 10:00am

Tickets will go on sale on the UWSP Ticket Sales website starting March 1st at 10am until March 28<sup>th</sup> at noon. <https://uwsptickets.universitytickets.com/>

Tickets will then be available for purchase at the KB Willett Ice Arena office during Technical and Dress Rehearsal evenings. Tickets will be available for purchase at the door one hour before each show performance. Ticket costs are \$10.00 for reserved seating and \$9.00 for General Admission. Special Needs/Assisted Seating is located on the top level of general admission seating. (Northwest corner of Ice Arena).

## REHEARSALS

All skaters must attend rehearsal sessions. Skaters may only miss **one** rehearsal and remain in the number. See the rehearsal schedule by group to find your rehearsal times. **Technical and Dress rehearsals are mandatory.**

Technical Rehearsal: Thursday, March 30th - 5:00pm- 8:30pm

Dress Rehearsal: Friday, March 31<sup>st</sup> - 5:00pm- 8:30pm (wear costume)

## SHOW TIME!

All skaters should be at the rink and in their assigned rooms approximately one-half hour before showtime.

**Staging room assignments during the ice show** - Phones and other recording devices are not allowed in changing areas. Parents/family members are not allowed in the locker rooms. To ensure a smooth-running show, we require all skaters to remain in their assigned room during the performances. All skaters will be able to watch the Technical & Dress Rehearsals.

## **SHOW Day Reminders:**

- 1.) Wear your costume during pictures, dress rehearsal and on show days only.
- 2.) Wear your tights and boot covers if applicable.
- 3.) All skaters should be at the rink and in their assigned rooms approximately one-half hour before showtime.
- 4.) Polish your skates.
- 5.) Have your name on all extra clothes, costumes, combs etc.
- 6.) Water only is allowed in the locker rooms. No food or beverages.
- 7.) Remove all belongings from rooms after each show.
- 8.) Support Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club by purchasing programs, flowers, and 50/50 raffle tickets at the show.

**RENTAL SKATES:** Rental Skates can be checked out from our skate rental room for the ice show starting on Monday, March 27th. There is no cost for you, but please treat them with care. Keep blades dry and only use on rubber flooring or rink ice. Please return the skates to the skate rental room after the final performance on Sunday. The user will be responsible for the replacement cost if skates are lost or damaged.

**VOLUNTEERS:** The Ice Show would not be possible without parents' and friends' assistance. Please watch for the sign-up board in the rink lobby. Volunteers are needed to monitor staging/changing rooms during each performance.

**CONCESSION STAND:** For your convenience, the concession stand will be open on Friday night for Dress Rehearsal from 4:00-8:00pm, serving pizza, hot dogs, and brats. The stand will also be just before each show until after intermission.

**SCHOOL SUPPLY DONATIONS:** In honor of this year's theme the Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club will be hosting a school supply drive at each show. Bring in new school supplies and receive a raffle ticket to win a basket of goodies! Supplies will be donated to Stevens Point Area Schools.

# 2023 ICE SHOW PICTURE DAY SCHEDULE

## SATURDAY, MARCH 4, 2023

All pictures will be taken at the KB Willett Arena in the large meeting room. Each group picture will be featured in the Ice Show program.

**Please arrive 30 min. prior to your picture time.**

Costume(s) are picked up at the rink when you arrive for pictures. The west end restrooms are where skaters can change into their costumes. The west end lobby area is used to put your personal items and gather before your group photo. Be ready 15 minutes prior to your picture time in case photos run ahead of schedule. Tights will be available for purchase but are **not** required to be worn for pictures. Tights **are** required to be worn in the Ice Show (if your costume does not have pants). The tights cost \$12 for child sizes and \$14 for adult sizes. Boot covers will also be available for purchase.

Empire Photography will take a group photo and individual photo of each skater in each group. Siblings wanting pictures together can do so at the end of one sibling's group. Friends wanting pictures together can do so at the end of one friend's group **\*\*this may be limited due to time.** All times are final and cannot be changed due to skater unavailability. No picture retakes will be offered.

It is your responsibility to get your photo taken, not the photographers. Picture ordering information will be emailed directly from Empire Photography to the email address used for Ice Show registration.
