The third show will be on Sunday, April 6th, at 2:00pm. **All participants must skate in all three shows.** We need the cooperation of all skaters and parents to prepare for this fantastic community event. ICE SHOW T-SHIRT DESIGN Submission deadline Tuesday, February 25th

Be the 2025 Ice Show t-shirt design winner! Submit your design via email to Katie Baeten at katherine.g.baeten@gmail.com by Tuesday, February 25th. Send a PDF of the design and include the skater's name in the email subject line and 't-shirt design' - example: Susie Q's t-shirt design.

Design Requirements: Registered skater in the show; 8.5" x 11" Sized White Paper (Portrait, not Landscape); Use one color (design will only be printed one color); Bold Outlining- Use marker or pen (not pencil); Must include "2025" and the title: *Animation On Ice*

Be original. DO NOT use pre-existing characters in design (Disney characters, Pixar characters, etc.) Skaters will vote to determine which one will be on the t-shirt. The winner gets a free t-shirt!

OPENING NUMBER Registration ends Tuesday, February 25th

The opening number is available to all Freestyle skaters registered for a Freestyle Number in the show (Inspector Gadget, Kim Possible, Up, Sing). The costume for this number is black widelegged athletic pants and the 2025 ice show t-shirt. We will have two rehearsals. You must be on the ice for both practices for the entire time to skate in the number. Please don't sign up if you know you can't make it to one of them. Please arrive on time. The shirt costs \$15.00 and needs to be ordered online. You cannot be in the number if a shirt is not ordered for you. Register Online under the Ice Show tab or at the rink office.

SHOW TICKETS GO ON SALE Tuesday, February 25th, 10:00 am

To give parents a head start on ticket sales, we will not advertise to the public until a week later. Tickets will be available online up until the start of each show. We are going paperless and will not offer cash ticket sales in person. However, we will help patrons buy tickets online at the rink as needed.

Ticket costs are \$10.00 for reserved seating and \$8.00 for General Admission. Ticket fees and tax will apply. Accessible seating is located on the top level of general admission seating.

PICTURE DAY & COSTUME DISTRIBUTION Saturday, March 1st

<u>Please see the picture day schedule in this packet for your skater's picture time.</u> Skaters' pictures will be published in the Ice Show Program. Each skater gets one program free of charge. Additional programs will be for purchase at each show or until supplies last.

Costumes will be picked up at the rink on picture day. In addition to your costume, all skaters need suntan-colored tights unless they are wearing pants as a costume. Tights will be available for \$8.00 for child sizes and \$10.00 for adult sizes. Female skaters wearing non-white skates must wear white boot covers. Males wearing non-black skates must wear black boot covers. Boot covers are not included with your costume but will be available for purchase at the arena for \$12/pair.

ICE SHOW T-SHIRT DESIGN VOTING ends Tuesday, March 4th

Skaters vote on the design they would like for the 2025 ice show t-shirt. An email with a link to vote will be sent soon after the art submission deadline. Each skater may vote once. If you have multiple skaters in your household, utilize the additional questions (2, 3, and 4) to vote.

The 2025 Ice Show opening number t-shirts are available to everyone! You do not need to be in the opening number to order a t-shirt. Shirts are 100% heavy cotton unisex Gildan tees with the winning design on the front and ice show participant names on the back. <u>Order Online</u> under the Ice Show tab or at the rink office.

ICE SHOW VIDEO ORDERS: orders are available until Monday, April 7th. 2025 Ice Show videos are brought to you by Sara's Custom Video. Keep the show alive with your own disc or digital file of this year's show. Add a single performance option when purchasing the digital file at checkout—this is a digital file option only. Digital files will be emailed. For those ordering discs, you will be notified of a pickup date once the videos are ready for distribution. The pick-up location will be the KB Willett office. Order online under the Ice Show tab or at the rink office.

RENTAL SKATES

Rental skates can be checked out from our skate shop for use in the ice show starting Monday, March 31st. There is no cost, but please treat them with care. Keep blades dry and only use on rubber flooring or rink ice. Please return the skates to the skate shop after the final performance on Sunday. The user will be responsible for the replacement cost if skates are lost or damaged.

REHEARSALS

All skaters must attend rehearsal sessions. Skaters may only miss <u>one</u> rehearsal and remain in the number. <u>See the rehearsal schedule by group to find your rehearsal times.</u>

Technical and Dress rehearsals are mandatory.

Technical Rehearsal: Thursday, April 3 - 5:00pm- 8:30pm

Dress Rehearsal: Friday, April 4 - 5:00pm- 8:30pm (wear costume)

CONCESSION STAND

The concession stand will be open for Dress Rehearsal from 4:30-8:00pm, serving pizza, hot dogs, and brats. Concessions will also be open a half hour before each show through intermission.

SHOW TIME!

All skaters should arrive dressed to the rink and in their assigned rooms approximately one-half hour before showtime.

Staging room assignments during the ice show – Skaters will be staged in various locations on the lower level of the arena. See the table below for your skaters' staging room. Parents/family members are not allowed in the locker rooms after the initial drop-off. To ensure a smooth-running show, we require all skaters to remain in their assigned room during the performances. All skaters will be able to watch the Technical & Dress Rehearsals.

Please take a few minutes to review the changing room/staging room SafeSkate policies in place during the ice show:

- Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club volunteers will monitor changing room areas periodically throughout the Ice Show to ensure that all athletes are abiding by their policies.
- Learn to Skate parent volunteers will monitor staging room areas throughout the Ice Show to ensure all athletes are safe, calm, and ready when it's their turn on the ice. These volunteers also have activities (coloring books, games) for the skaters to pass the time when they are not performing.

- Changing areas are monitored by the Two Deep leadership method to minimize one-on-one interactions between minors and adults.
- Cell phones and other mobile devices with recording capabilities, including voice recording, still cameras, and video cameras, are prohibited from being used in changing rooms or staging rooms.
- Separate changing areas will be available for male and female athletes.
- Athletes under the age of 11 who require parent assistance Should utilize changing tents located in the upper-level Skyward Room.
- Synchro Skaters in Cinderella, Madagascar, or Hercules, are to utilize the changing tents located in the upper-level skyward meeting space to change with the assistance of their parent. Skaters are not allowed to change in "staging room" spaces. Skaters must wear their Ice Show Group Number costumes during the Finale.
- Athletes 18 years of age and older will be allowed in locker rooms with their teammates under the age of 18 ONLY if they have completed the SafeSport training.

VOLUNTEERS:

The Ice Show would not be possible without the assistance of parents and friends. Please watch for the sign-up board in the rink lobby. Volunteers are needed to monitor staging rooms during each performance. Thank you in advance.

SHOW DAY REMINDERS:

- Wear your costume during pictures, dress rehearsal, and on show days only.
- Wear your tights and boot covers if applicable.
- All skaters should be in their assigned rooms approximately one-half hour before showtime.
- Polish your skates.
- Costume accessories are kept on-site and put on/removed by Ice Show staff before/after performances. Accessories are then sent home with skaters after Sunday's performances.
- Have your name on all extra clothes, costumes, personal items, etc. Skaters must have their names on skate guards to ensure they are returned to them.
- Water is only allowed in the locker rooms. No food or beverages.
- Remove all belongings from rooms after each show.
- Support Crystal Ice Figure Skating Club by purchasing programs, flowers, and 50/50 raffle tickets at the show.

2025 ICE SHOW PICTURE DAY SCHEDULE SATURDAY, MARCH 1, 2025

All pictures will be taken at the KB Willett Arena in the Skyward Room. Each group picture will be featured in the Ice Show program.

Please arrive 30 min. prior to your picture time.

Start by picking up your costume in the east lobby when you arrive for pictures. Skates are worn for photos. Tights will be available for purchase but are **not** required to be worn for pictures. Tights **are** required to be worn in the Ice Show (if your costume does not have pants). Boot covers will also be available for purchase on picture day. West-end restrooms will be available for changing into costumes. Be ready 10 minutes before your picture time in case photos run ahead of schedule.

The photographer will take a group photo and individual photo of each skater in each group. Siblings wanting pictures together can do so at the end of one sibling's group. Friends wanting pictures together can do so at the end of one friend's group **This may be limited due to time. All times are final and cannot be changed due to skater unavailability. No picture retakes will be offered.
